12 neighbors, including board members Erin, Lisa, Mert and Andrea, in attendance.

Approval of the May minutes and treasurer's report were postponed until July meeting

Treasurer Andrea announced she was moving out of the neighborhood and was resigning from the board. She wished the association the best of luck and said she hopes it continues to grow and strive.

Erin explained the delay in logo voting saying board members had to take time to make sure that the list of paid members was complete, and we had correct email address with no duplicates. She encouraged members to watch for the voting email in their inboxes.

Guest Speaker - PAR Officer Jacob Boomgaarden

Officer Boomgaarden explained that he is involved in more community events this time of year and is relying on beat cops more to help patrol the neighborhood. He said he is still dealing with the issue at the car wash in the neighborhood, but the business owner has put up a no loitering notice which now allows officers the ability to write tickets or arrest offenders that are there. Discussed issue of an invasive neighbor that a member has brought up at a recent meeting. He went through the process of explaining how neighbors and local law officers can deal with suspects that may have mental issues. He also said that his availability is hit and miss right now as his unit get used as extras for city events and recently worked the pride parade.

Old Business

- Erin reminded members that National Night out would be coming up and would be held up at Meador Park. She said sign up would be in July and we planned to sign up and have a table.

New Business

- Discussed the transition for having a new treasurer. Erin announced that the board had approved General Member Mert Seaton as the new treasurer and the board would be looking for volunteers to take the now vacant general member spot on the board.
- Discussed logo voting in more detail and that members should compare and choose what they felt was the best option. Erin encouraged members to look at other neighborhood logos so they could see what did and did not work best for signs, color and changes in size.
- One member asked about Next Door Brentwood website and if it was specific to our neighborhood. It was explained that Next Door has them for all neighborhoods and that specific site is not associated with our association. Erin pointed out that the Next Door Brentwood map does not match up with the map the city has for the Brentwood Neighborhood.
