Guest Speaker - PAR Officer Jacob Boomgaarden

Officer Boomgaarden discussed that he had several reports of issues from the car wash. There have been reports of loud music, drug use, etc. and he was working with the owner on a solution. He advised that a noise disturbance between the hours of 7 AM and 11 PM cannot be reported anonymously. Any noise disturbance between 11 PM and 7 AM can be anonymous. Officer Boomgaarden spoke privately with a neighbor who is new to the group but had some serious concerns about another neighbor on her street.

Alana came to speak with the association about the Great Neighborhood program. She explained that grants are awarded based on several different factors. The activities that the neighborhood must complete should fall into one of the following categories: Safe, clean and friendly. There are many things that the neighborhood can do to earn points.
